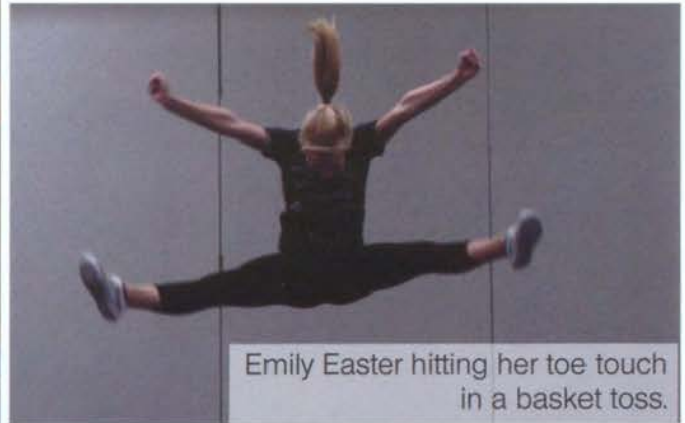

With a combined GPA of 3.78, varsity girls soccer made the Dairy Farmer All-Academic Top 10 list for 5A schools, finishing fourth overall.



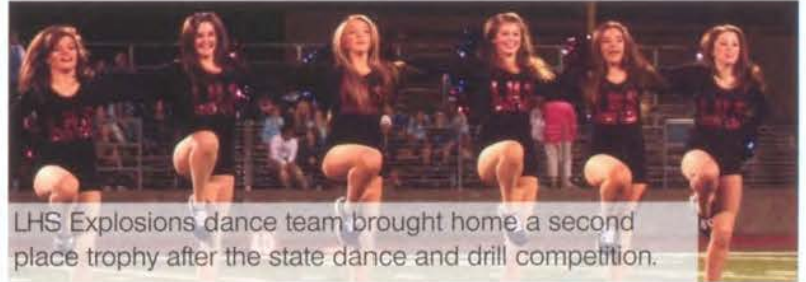
Boys swimming placed second in districts and girls finished third. Maddy Kelly won her 4th state championship, a school record.



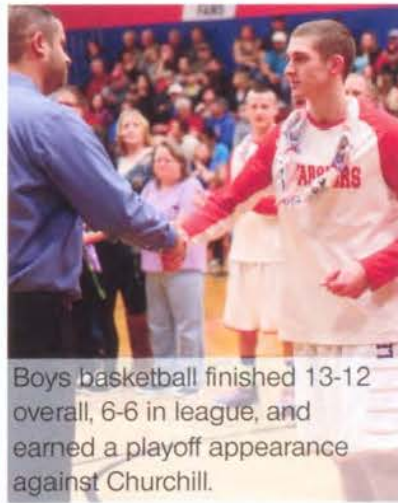

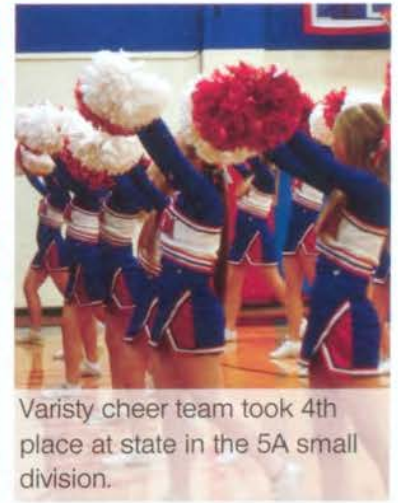
Varsity volleyball finished 14-0 as league champions. They were ranked first in-state for several weeks, and finished fourth at the state tournament.

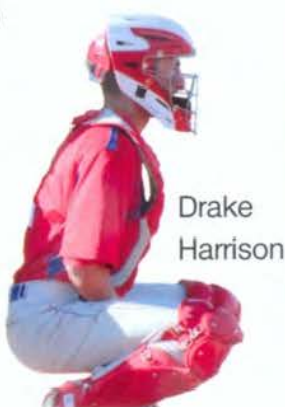
