Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This one-story Gothic Revival residence has a steeply sloped gable roof, projected verges, shiplap siding and corner boards. The main wing of the original T-shape floor plan paralleled the street. A one-story wing has been added on the south, parallel to the street. The gable end facing the street, now in the middle of the west facade, contains paired, one/one double-hung windows on each floor. There is a hip roof porch on the left with turned posts. A paneled door is located on the right side and there are one/one, double-hung windows at the center and in the center gable. The south wing has a hip roof porch with turned posts and two one/one, double-hung windows on the right of the modern door. There are corbeled chimneys straddling the ridges of the south wing and of the older section.

The south gable end has a four/four, double-hung window at the peak. There is a low-pitched, gable roof porch with a corrugated metal wall attached on the southwest corner. The north gable end features a one/one, double-hung window above a one-story, hip roof addition containing three one/one, double-hung windows.
