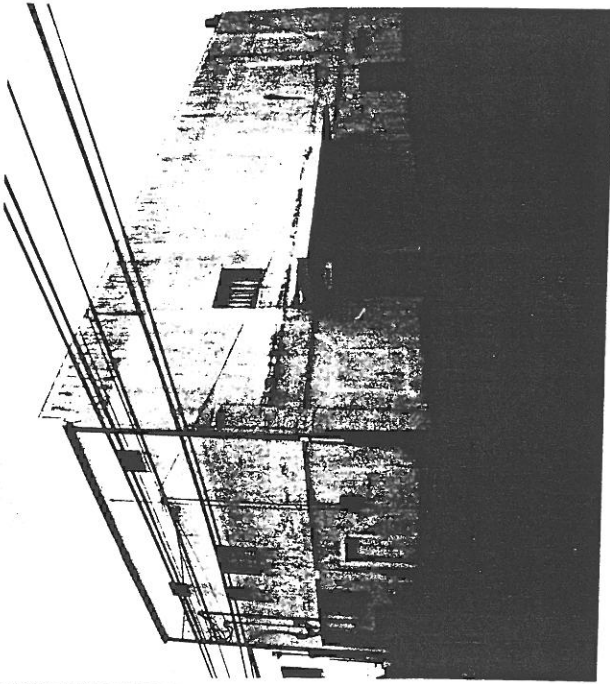

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This is a two-story commercial building with stuccoed walls and a flat roof. The south elevation has been modernized with most of the architectural features removed. There are four bays divided by pilasters at the ground level. The bay at the west end contains an entry to the Masonic Lodge. The adjacent bay contains two new large single-light fixed windows with an awning above. The bay just to the east of this has an entry to the interior ground floor space that is shared with the adjacent Andrews Hackleman Building. The bay at the east end has been completely filled. Seven pilasters show through the plaster of the blank second floor wall.
