Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This one-story commercial building has a round roof and a rectangular floor plan with a recent addition on the east. Five bays on the south are divided by piers. The middle bays contain only large aluminum frame windows. Doors are located in the end bays and the main entry at the southwest corner. Above the windows there is a flat awning. The parapet is also divided by the piers and steps up in the center where a flag pole is located.

The west elevation is divided by piers into three large glass filled bays on ground level and a stepped parapet above the awning. The addition on the east is nearly the size of the older building. Its stuccoed south facade is unfenestrated and contains three groups of three, three-light aluminum frame fixed windows. The entry is offset to the east.
