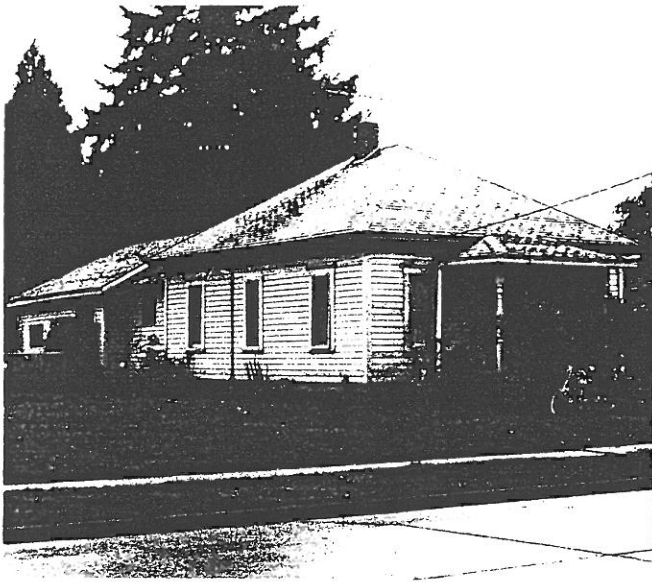

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This is a one-story Queen Anne cottage with a hip roof on the front rooms. The front porch has a hip roof, turned posts and an added wall along the south side. There is a tall one/one, double-hung window on the left of the entry and on the right a larger one containing with leaded glass in an intersecting tracery pattern in the top panel. The south elevation contains two one/one, double-hung windows with cornice moldings. There are three similar windows on the north elevation. The house is clad with shiplap siding with corner boards, and vertical siding below the water table. There is a center brick chimney. A low east-west oriented wing has been added at the rear.
