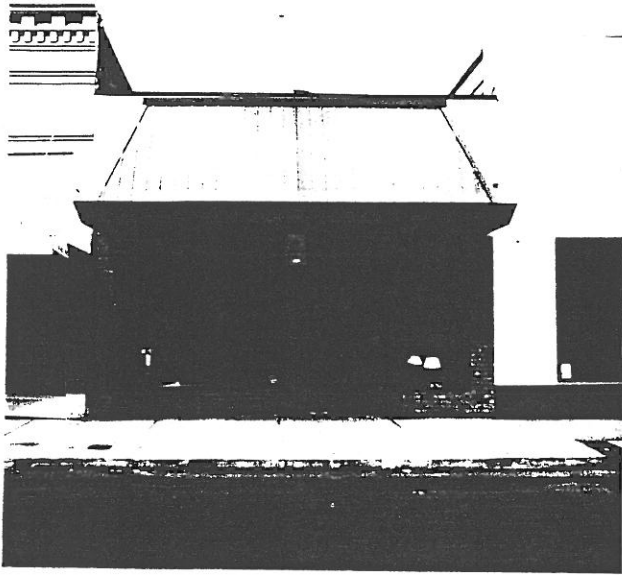

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This is a one-story commercial brick building with a modernized facade, a rectangular floor plan and a flat roof. The lower portion of the east facade is clad with brick while the parapet is stuccoed. The entry is recessed and features an aluminum frame glass door. A large single-light store display window is located on each side of the entry but both are different sizes due to the entry's location to the north of center. An awning, with a sloped roof connecting to the top of the parapet, shelters the length of the facade.

History

One of the first occupants was the Santiam Sporting Goods store which also had a workshop for repairing appliances. At the turn of the century there was a doctor's office located here in a small wood frame building.
