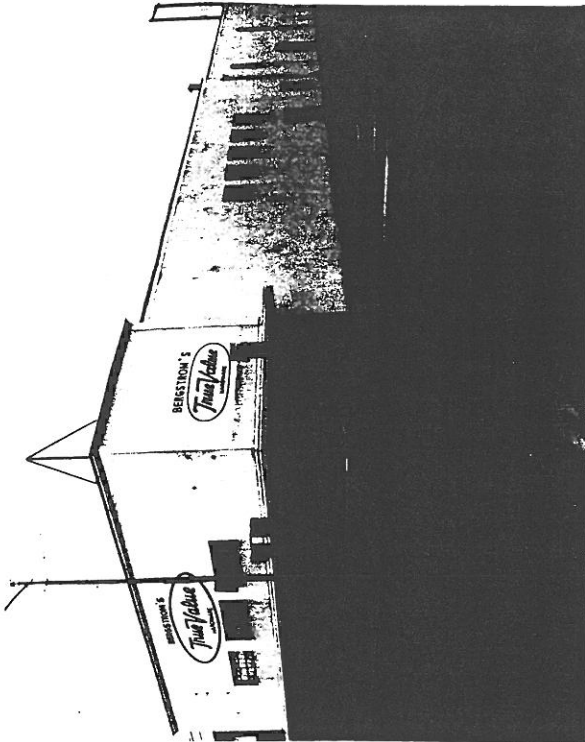

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Groves Hardware Building was remodeled into a two-story Moderne style, stuccoed brick building with a flat roof and rectangular floor plan. The east elevation at street level has green tile divided with metal strips, large plate glass windows and a recessed center entry. The stuccoed second floor contains three openings filled with glass block, has a small sheet metal cornice, and is separated from below by a flat metal awning.

The store windows, tiles, awning and cornice wrap around the northeast corner then end. Near the center of the north facade there are five second floor metal casement windows above a rear entry. The west portion of the building still exhibits original wall surface treatment and features segmentally -arched windows and door openings.
