Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Stoops House is a one story Neo-Classical structure with a pyramidal roof and a hip roofed rear wing. There is a porch on the south side of the east elevation which features turned posts and a one/one, double hung window. There is a large fixed window to the north and two more on the north facing side elevation. The back wing contains a new door and windows. The south elevation has two original double-hung windows. The structure is clad with shiplap siding and corner boards, and there is a corbelled brick center chimney. The rear wing originally contained a north facing porch which has been filled in.

The Stoops House was built for Mrs. Stoops. The current owners purchased the property from Harvey Freitag who bought the house in 1937.
